One by one everybody arrived safely and enjoyed the welcome $\,\dots\,$




in the UNIK Restaurant at the Design-Hotel Rex.





Following that, we were spoiled by the dinner in the above mentioned restaurant with its unusual courses.

It was really exciting to be able to see various planes from the history of Airbus from the inside as well.




It was even possible to take a look at the airlines' luggage compartments.

The Airbus Super Guppy transports huge aircraft elements between the various Airbus production sites.




One way, as a non-pilot, to enjoy the flight.

We drove to Lourdes, but not just to enjoy a very good dinner at the Restaurant Alexandra.




Rather shocking to see how you can make money out of the faithful – almost surreal.


The Rosary Basilica was where we were heading.



Holy water.








